

GLOBAL RESOURCE CHAMPIONS SPLIT CORP. ANNOUNCES 2017 SEMI-ANNUAL RESULTS

TORONTO, August 30, 2017 – Global Resource Champions Split Corp. (“Global Resource Champions” or the “Company”) announced today that its net assets per unit, as determined for financial reporting purposes, was USD\$45.06 at June 30, 2017. All amounts are stated in US dollars.

Portfolio securities and net assets totaled \$82 million and \$48 million, respectively, as at June 30, 2017. The Company commenced operations on May 6, 2016, upon completion of an initial public offering of 1,800,000 Class A Preferred Shares, Series 1 (the “preferred shares”) at C\$25.00 per Share (the “offering”), for gross proceeds of C\$45 million. Concurrent with the Offering, the Company issued 1,800,000 capital shares to Partners Value Fund Investments Inc. for C\$55 million. The net asset value per unit, as determined for retraction purposes, is posted daily on our website at www.globalchampions.com.
